



- SHOW DESCRIPTION -

TIME & SETTING:

1900-1910 in Grovers Corners, New Hampshire

Our Town presents the small town of Grover's Corners in three acts: "Daily Life," "Love and Marriage" and "Death and Eternity" Narrated by a stage manager and performed with minimal props and sets, the play depicts the simple daily lives of the Webb and Gibbs families as their children fall in love, marry, and eventually – in one of the most famous scenes in American theatre – die.



RUN TIME:

Approx. 120 minutes with two 10-minute intermissions between acts

Are you a teen who LOVES theatre? Apply to join our teen ensemble! Participants learn to produce theatre from selecting shows, to learning to market and fundraise. Ensemble members participate in a weekly meeting where they work out the logistics. They get guarenteed casting in all of the shows and first pick on which production areas they want to work in (costuming, set, lighting etc.). - CAST BIOS & HEADSHOTS -



Isabel Bennett (Woman in Balcony/Lady in the Box): This is Isabel Bennett's first show with Childsplay. She has been in three school performances such as Shrek Jr, Alice in Wonderland Jr, and Legally Blonde Jr.



Kris Diaz (Joe Stoddard): This is Kris' first time at Childsplay, and he is excited to be in a YETi production. Kris doesn't have too much acting experience, he has only been in 2 productions: Matilda the Musical Jr. and The Phantom Tollbooth, both at Kyrene Middle School.

Bre Jackson (Emily Webb) is thrilled to be a part of Our Town playing Emily Webb. A passionate performer, this is Bre's first production with Childsplay. Bre Interned for Childsplay over the summer and loved every second of it. It has been an honor for her to accept this role. Notable past performances include The Neverending Story as Falkor, Big Bad as Fairy Godmother, and The Lion King as Zazu showcasing her versatility and dedication to the craft. Bre has won 3 awards for her acting abilities including 'best actress in a comedic role,' 'best actress in a trouser role,' 'best actress in a play.' 


