
- SHOW DESCRIPTION -

TIME & SETTING: 1995; Athens, Ohio, and the imaginary land of New Landia

She Kills Monsters tells the story of high schooler Agnes Evans as she deals with the death of her younger sister, Tilly. When Agnes stumbles upon Tilly's Dungeons & Dragons notebook, she finds herself catapulted into a journey of discovery and action-packed adventure in the imaginary world that was her sister's refuge. In this high-octane dramatic comedy laden with homicidal fairies, nasty ogres, and '90s pop culture, acclaimed playwright Qui Nguyen offers a heart-pounding homage to the

geek and warrior within us all.

Run Time: Approximately 90 Minutes This performance will feature the use of strobe lights.
