About the Production

JSonic and the Unknown is a world premiere play by Idris Goodwin and is a part of the BIPOC Superhero Project.



When JSonic, the intergalactic hero known for his sonic powers, crash-lands on the eerily silent planet of Whisper, he finds himself in a world where noise is forbidden and sound is a myth. Stranded and stripped of his abilities, he must ally with a band of unlikely heroes—mysterious locals who secretly yearn for the sounds of freedom. Together, they ignite a rhythmic rebellion to overthrow the oppressive silence, sparking a battle that will resonate across the cosmos. Can JSonic restore the beat and bring harmony back to Whisper, or will silence consume the galaxy forever?

Childsplay is seeking four actors from a variety of backgrounds to tell this intergalactic tale. BIPOC performers who are comfortable with rapping are strongly encouraged to audition.

Maddi's Fridge

About the Production:

Maddi's Fridge is a play by Anne Negri, based on the book by Lois Brandt.

Maddi and Sofia are best friends. They play in their neighborhood park together. Maddi is really good at climbing the rock wall, while Sofia is a fast runner. One day, Sofia discovers that Maddi has no food in her fridge at home. Sofia wants to help her friend, but Maddi makes her promise not to tell anyone. What should Sofia do? Based on the book by Lois Brandt, this play is a gentle, yet sometimes hilarious exploration of friendship, empathy, and doing the right thing.

Childsplay is seeking three actors (two female actors, one male actor) to tell this charming story. *Please note: This production is a van tour that will tour nationally for eight weeks in the fall.* Exact dates TBA. Cast members take turns driving and assist in load-ins, strikes, and other duties.

About the Production:

The Imaginators is a play by Childsplay Artistic Director Dwayne Hartford.

Siblings Anne and Tim have just moved into a new neighborhood. Tim is an incredibly imaginative younger brother and Anne is a self-conscious and somewhat insecure older sister who is concerned about making friends and being as smart as the "big city" kids. When Nina, a precocious and clever girl from next door, surprises Tim in the middle of one of his "adventures," the games begin! Nina and Tim have no trouble at all making up stories and playing them out. It is Anne who is apprehensive and would rather work on her computer, but Nina coaxes Anne into going on a great make-believe adventure.

Using moving boxes and other objects found in the garage, Nina creates the world of Garagenia complete with poetic language, creative images, royalty, and monsters. The three battle the child-eating monster, the Mooklecratz and discover their own strengths and the value of cooperation as they figure out how to defeat the beast.

Childsplay is seeking four actors (two female actors, two male actors) to tell this imaginative tale. This production will tour schools and libraries throughout the Phoenix metro area, with some performances in cities and towns across Arizona. *BIPOC actors are strongly encouraged to audition*.

Childsplay is seeking ten actors to perform all the roles in our annual holiday production. Open roles TBD. Some cast members from previous years are expected to return. *BIPOC musical theatre performers are strongly encouraged to audition*.

What To Prepare

Auditioners **must** reserve an audition timeslot by Friday, April 4, 2025. To schedule an audition appointment, email us at <u>casting@childsplayaz.org</u>.

Headshot & Resume are required. Please submit Headshot and Resume with your request for an audition time.

Each auditionee has 2 minutes to complete the audition. Auditions can consist of monologues or songs (either or a combination of the two.) *The total time should not exceed 2 minutes*. Auditionees will be cut off at the 2-minute mark. Timing begins at the start of the first monologue or song.

For in-person auditionees, hook-ups for recorded accompaniment will be provided.

Video Auditions

If auditionees are unable to attend the In-Person or Virtual Auditions, Video Auditions will also be accepted.

Auditionees must send Headshot, Resume, and 2-Minute Video Audition to casting@childsplayaz.org by Monday, April 7, 2025. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Video Audition submissions can consist of monologues or songs (either or a combination of the two.) *The total time should not exceed 2 minutes*.
